Famous Railroad Story Screened By Universal.

Fifteen freight cars, two locomotives and other railroad equipment were used in the Clarence Brown unit from Universal City at Port Bragg, in northern California where for Virginia Valli's new starring vehicle, "The Signal Tower," was filmed. The new production, a Universal super Jewel, comes Saturday to the Star theater.

A portable signal tower, around which the central interest in the story is woven, and in which many of the major sequences take place, was built in the studio and transported to the north country. It was set up at a siding along the California Western Railroad and navigation company tracks between Port Bragg and Willets, in the Sierras.

The company, which included besides the director, his first and second assistants, Charles Dorian and Ernest Laemmle, a cast of six persons and a production unit—carpenters, electricians and property hands—of about twenty-five persons, stayed at Noyo river. Lunch was eaten under the giant redwoods.

"The Signal Tower," adapted from Walsworth Camp's prize short story, is Miss Valli's first starring feature since she finished work in "A Lady of Quality." It is also Brown's first directorial effort since "The Aqueduct," one of Universal's sensational successes of the season. The cast includes Rockliffe Keller, William Broy, James O. Harrows, J. Farrell McDonald, Frankie Darro and Dot Farley.

My Man Showing For Last Time at Sherrys Tonight.

There is something about "My Man," the offering at Sherry theater which seems to appeal to everyone. Perhaps it is due to the Bette manner and consistency in which it is presented. Or perhaps it is the story which is an adaptation of George Randolph Chester's popular novel, "A Tale of Red Roads."

The screen presentation has all the earmarks of one of Chester's successful tales of American life with its satire, plots and counterplots, get-rich-quick schemes and novel situations.

Speaking of situations one cannot help calling attention to those sequences in which large quantities of roses are used and to those beautiful sequences presenting a gorgeous display of fireworks in natural colors. All that was needed to make the illusion complete was the almost deafening explosion of the bursting rockets, the state and spluttering of the explosion, although at times the imagination was deluded by eyes and it almost seemed as though one could hear these noises.

Then there is the trick dog that has one sequence that stands out in bold relief against all animal sequences, the scene in which he puts his paw to his head in despair.

These novelties are but incidents in an altogether pleasing picture, film that has a purpose, a story to offer and offers it without wading through endless sequences to get to the point. There is always a place apathy in the action and the honest criticism is that we could see more of each scene and enjoy it. Movement seems to be the motto of Vitaphone and one is convinced that pictures certainly do move after seeing "My Man."
