Mindanao Now Prepared To Enter Rubber Market

MANILA (AP) — Actual quantity production of crude rubber for the market will start in Cotabato province, island of Mindanao, within a month, it was announced today. A shipment of machinery for a rubber plant was made recently from Zamboanga to Cotabato, consigned to the La Grande Rubber Estate at Kabacan, Cotabato, and it is expected the installation will be made by the end of August. The company has a large number of trees just maturing and it expects to add further acreages. It already has a considerable acreage which will mature within a few years.

CHEAP AMERICAN COAL SHUTS DOWN WELSH MINES

LONDON (AP) — Closing down of two coal mines in the Welsh fields during the last week, which brings the number of mines now idle in the larger fields to 15, is the result of a serious falling off of the export trade, say the operators.

Competition from America, where coal is being sold under English prices, and the fact that the settlement of the Ruhr trouble has reopened that source of supply, is responsible for the decrease in exports, an official of the operators' association said.

Production has dropped from 22,000,000 tons in 1913 to 27,000,000 tons in 1924.

## PALACE WILL BECOME HOTEL

CONSTANTINOPLE (AP) — Rumors that Dolma Bagiche, the palace of the ex-Sultan Mohammed V, is to be sold to a company which will convert the imperial residence and extensive grounds into a hotel and amusement park, have stirred up much excitement in the old Turkish capital. Will the Seraglio go next? Is the question generally asked. Is the whole Bosphorus to be converted into a "Midway Plaisance"? Will the Argon government sacrifice the ancient landmarks of the Turkish empire in an effort to raise money to keep the Nationalist government going?

Turks and foreigners alike are asking these questions as they survey the panorama of mosques and palaces along the Golden Horn and Bosphorus which lend charm to this ancient city over which Europe and Asia have been fighting for many centuries.

Palma Bagiche was erected in 1552. It stands near the shore of the Bosphorus. On the hills behind it are magnificent grounds, and among the forest trees are many smaller residences as well as the Yildiz Kiosk, where recent sultans went on Fridays for their weekly prayers.

Mohammed V, the sultan who was forced to abdicate by the Mustafa Kemal government, lived in recent years in one of the houses back from the waterfront. He preferred to be away from the sight of the battleships of many nations which lay along the Bosphorus. It was at Yildiz Kiosk that foreigners have gathered for many years to watch the sultans make their imperial march from the palace every Friday, to bow with more humble Mohammedans in reverence, with their faces toward Mecca.

Vagrant Mines Menace Ships

DOVER, Eng. (AP) — There are still several explosive mines, relics of the war, floating about in the Baltic Sea and in the English Channel, according to reports which are being filed almost weekly by captains of vessels which ply in these waters. A ship coming from Antwerp recently reported a mine off the Goodwin Lightship in the channel, and two others were reported nearby by the captain of a vessel sailing from Russia.
