Betty Braves Lions Making Latest Paramount Production.

Its popularity was due largely to the originality of treatment with which Dillon handled the story, and he was rewarded immediately by a contract to make five more productions for Associated First National Pictures, Inc.

"Danger" a Real Red-Blooded Moving Picture.

J. R. Warner, in Clifford S. Elwell's newest production, "Danger," at Sherry's today only, undoubtedly gives the best performance he has given during his meteoric career as a star. His work is realistic to the last degree, and thanks to an excellent, interesting story by Frank Howard Clark, Warner is given the opportunity of displaying his prowess as a daredevil horseman in a fashion that is truly hair-raising.

But back of the many thrilling moments incorporated in the picture, there is a love story that is fascinatingly gripping and that Director Elwell has brought out in a very entertaining manner.
