(By the Associated Press)—Ole Nelson, former Portland policeman, who recently won a suit from the city for over \$6,000 back pay, was instantly killed when an automobile overturned on the highway near here. Nelson, his niece, was seriously injured. Nelson was pinned on the police pension list last Thursday.

After Nelson's car passed a truck the front wheel went off the pavement on a curve. The car lurched across the road into a ditch, overturning. Nelson was pinned beneath the car after being dragged 25 feet. No blame was attached to the passing truck driver.

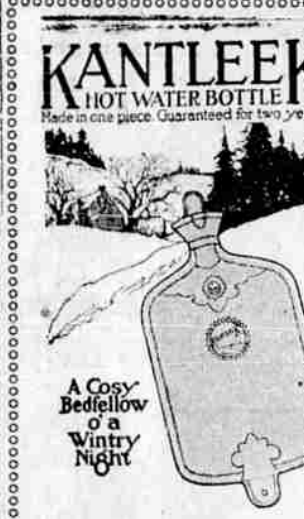
