World Dominion Is Being Transferred

The lecture given yesterday at the Eagles hall by M. L. Herr on "World Dominion Being Transferred" was well attended, and the speaker was given good attention as he unfolded a brief history of the world, showing the causes of the present distress upon the nations. The speaker said in part:

The World War came as a shock because it was thought humanity was so far advanced that war was practically outlawed through the preaching of the Gospel. But that the world was far from that heart condition which is conducive to peace may be readily seen by the selfishness manifested during the war in the greed and profiteering which has stirred the world and caused it to quake.

The Scriptures describe our day saying: "Upon the earth distress of nations with perplexity; the sea and waves roaring; men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth; for the powers of heaven shall be shaken." (Luke 21:25,26.) The powers of heaven mean the spiritual ruling powers of ecclesiasticism. This it forecasts a commotion in the religious world. This we see has already developed among those called Modernists and Fundamentalists. This controversy is only getting started, and all will do well to acquaint themselves with the facts on both sides.

The prophet Isaiah (24:20,21) says: "The earth shall reel to and fro like a drunkard, and shall be removed like a cottage; and the transgression thereof shall be heavy upon it; and it shall fall, and not rise again. And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall punish the host of the high ones that are on high, and the kings of the earth upon the earth." The earth here means the people of the present social order; and they are bewildered and confused, because no one seems to know how to lead the way out. The punishment coming to the high ones and to the kings means that they shall be rendered powerless, and when this is recognized they will be "as prisoners," in the context suggests.

The Pentateuch (197:26,27) gives his verdict: "Their soul is melted because of trouble. They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are as their wits' end." And verses 28-30 show that God will bring the world out of its trouble, and bring peace and quietness, and make the world of mankind glad.

Why is this great change taking place? Satan has long been a heavy hand over mankind, causing slavery, ignorance, superstition and selfishness to hold it, in order that humanity should not have the freedom, intelligence, wisdom and love that God intended that it should have. Satan's rulership has been a usurped one, out of harmony with the character of God, but permitted by Him until another feature of His plan should mature. The time of liberation has come, and therefore the trouble in the world is the natural consequence.

The first dominion of earth was given to Adam, over 6000 years ago. (Genesis 1:26, 28.) He disobeyed and lost all. "Misery and woe, war and bloodshed, sickness and death, have pursued the race with a relentless vengeance from that day to this—so long, in fact, that many erroneously conclude that these must follow mankind until all go into the tomb.

God chose the children of Abraham to be His representative people in the earth until the "seed of promise" should come. The seed, Paul explains, is Christ and His church glorified. Kings were chosen in Israel from the tribe of Judah. Most of the kings were bad kings; and when the nation of Israel got apparently beyond reformation, God removed their king and declared that the kingdom should remain overturned until he comes whose right it is and it would then be given to him. The one referred to is unquestionably Jesus and His church for Daniel (7:27) says: "The kingdom and dominion and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the Most High."

The prophetic, or God-given blessing, which Jacob pronounced

over Judah was: "The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be." (Genesis 49:10) Sceptre means the right to rule; and though Zebekiah had been dethroned in 606 B. C., the right of rulership was not lost to the tribe of Judah, and Jesus was declared to be the "Lion of the tribe of Judah." Shiloh has reference to the Prince of Peace, which title belongs to Jesus at his second advent, rather than at the first advent—Isaiah 9:6.

When the dominion was lost in 606 B. C., there began to count the "times of the Gentiles," a clearly defined, marked-off period of 2520 years, which reached to 1914 A. D., the very time when the World War began its devastation into the kingdoms of the earth and to be overthrown. When we understand that Jesus and those who reign with him in glory are spirit beings, unseen by natural eyesight, it is not hard to comprehend how Jesus at that time could have assumed control over nations and is now dashing them to pieces as a potter's vessel.

The expressions, "Lion of the tribe of Judah," and "Tower of the flock" (Isaiah 41:9), imply that there are others with Jesus in the heavenly realm, and signify that the first resurrection is in process of consummation. (See Luke 12:32 and Revelation 20:6) May it not be, then that the world unknowingly is passing over the threshold of the Messianic kingdom into that wonderful time when the earth shall yield her increase and become like Eden, and when the human family will get well of all sickness, grow into the virility of youth, and thence into mental, moral and physical perfection and live forever?—Jeremiah 33:6; Isaiah 33:24; Job 33:24-26.

The kingdom for which Christians have so long prayed is at the door. This means a kingdom of peace and happiness and life upon the earth. Then the Lord shall make wars to cease upon the face of the earth." Nation shall not lift sword against nation; neither shall they learn war any more; the peace shall then enter into its inheritance. — Psalm 47:9; John 8:51.

150 CASES OF EGGS SHIPPED IN WEEK

AMERICAN FALLS, Idaho. — The southern Idaho part of the Idaho-Oregon Egg association closed October 12 and up to October 23, 150 cases of eggs a week began arriving at the Pocatello office. They graded A-1 quality better than 50 per cent and are selling at 46 cents with other grades in proportion. The local egg market is 43 cents and is now governed by the egg association.

The volume of production coming into Pocatello is not high, according to County Agent Tillotson, but is better than expected for October, the poorest egg month of the year. The biggest problem confronting the association is building up production and the encouragement received is very gratifying to the association.

Members had the opportunity of cancelling contracts prior to October 1, but of the entire membership only three cancelled.

L. E. Tillotson is temporarily taking care of shipments out of Pocatello county which are made Tuesdays and Thursdays. A supply of shipping cases was received for members.


