Genuine Drama in "Tiger Thompson" At Sherrys.

With a picture like "Tiger Thompson" it is easy to understand why Harry Carey is the most beloved two-fisted hero of the films.

At the Sherry theater yesterday where this famous cowboy star opened a two days' engagement in his new Hunt Stromberg production, the audience discovered that a western may have all the genuine drama and heart appeal of any other kind of screen entertainment.

Which does not mean, however, that the thrill element is lacking. The blast for the heroes, the hair-raising scenes of the heroine from the curving backboard, the train robbery and the trio of fights give "Tiger Thompson" all the punches that the excitement seeker craves.

But as is not usual with such pictures, there is a logical reason for each thrill and underlying the entire picture is a human story whose leading character tugs mightily at the heart.

"Tiger Thompson" affords Carey his best opportunity at characterization to date. And he makes of the reformed bandit, whose efforts to remain straight keep him constantly in danger, a figure of genuine appeal.

Marguerite Clayton is a winsome and fearless heroine, and John W. Dillon and Jack Richardson prove what capable players they are by making the audience actually hiss them in certain scenes.

"Breezy" Reeves Eason, one of the screen's foremost directors of this type of entertainment, managed to inject numerous clever touches and kept the action moving at a fast clip every moment. Comedy showing "Jonah Jones."

"Love and Glory" Begins Run at Arcade Monday.

"Love and Glory," the Ruper, Julian-Universal-Jewel production, opening next Monday to the Arcade theatre, presents a distinct novelty in the way of screen entertainment in that its characters live through a fifty year lapse of time.

The three famed characters, portrayed by Charles De Roche, Wallace MacDonald and Madge Bellamy, are introduced in the story as young peasant folk in a French village. In the closing scenes of the film they appear in the makeup of persons seventy years of age. So real is the transfiguration that it is said to be difficult to believe that the characters are portrayed by the same players. It is a triumph for the actors, as well as for the director.

Pictorially the production is one of the most beautiful of the year. Gilbert Warren, credited on the screen with the photoplay, can take many a blow for his skilful camera work.

One sequence of the picture, however, reflects a desert engagement between Zouaves and Arabs and it is colorful and dramatic, carrying one of the biggest thrills of the story.

The screen play is an adaptation of the novel, "We Are French," written by Percy Poore Shoshan and Robert Davis. Other featured players are: Gibson Gowland, Ford Sterling, Charles De Ravenna and Priscilla Dean Moran.
