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LOWERING OF PRICES OCCUR

Substantial price reductions on
Hudson and Essex coaches were
announced today by E. L. Ledbet-
ter, following the receipt of a spe-
cial message from the Hudson Mo-
tor Car company.

The reduction results in the Hud-
son coach, a closed car, now selling
at less than the standard open car
on the same chassis. This is the
first time in motor car history when
this has been true. It is declared
the Hudson coach's new list price
is \$1295, as against \$1400 for the
4-passenger open Super-Six car and
\$1500 for the 7-passenger open car.

The Essex coach at \$945 is still
slightly higher than the Essex open
car, but the differential is declared
by Hudson-Essex officials to be
the smallest in the industry aside
from Hudson.

This move by the Hudson Motor
Car company—unexpected, because
the last few weeks has seen a sub-
stantial number of motor car price
increases—is taken to mean that
Hudson-Essex now regards open
cars as luxuries, and proposes to
give the advantage of volume pro-
duction to the enclosed cars which
make up at least 90 per cent of its
production. Open car and sedan
prices are unchanged.

The reduction was made possible,
according to Hudson officials, be-
cause 1924 has been the largest
sales year in Hudson history, the
hitherto unknown 700,000 mark
having been reached about Septem-
ber 1. Volume economies have
thus been possible.

"This advantage in price is made
possible to buyers because Hudson-
Essex followed their creation of
coaches with volume production.
This keeps Hudson-Essex enclosed
cars out of the range of price com-
petition.

Glaciers of Colorado Are Vanishing Slowly

BOULDER, Colo. (AP).—Colo-
rado's glaciers are vanishing slow-
ly, according to Professor Junius
Henderson, curator of the museum
of the University of Colorado.

Disintegration of the ice sheets
has resulted largely from the ex-
cessive hot weather and dry sea-
sons during the last few years. The
great ice masses on the glacier
peaks of the Rockies have been in
slow retreat for the last 22 years,
Professor Henderson declares.

"However, the retreat has been
very rapid since 1915," he said.
"For climatic conditions have been
unfavorable to the accumulation or
preservation of ice during that
period. This is particularly notice-
able in the Arapahoe glacier, the
largest in Colorado.

"If disintegration continues at
the present rate, all the glaciers in
the state will disappear with the
possible exception of two, the Ara-
pahoe and the largest St. Vrain."

Professor Henderson expressed
the opinion that the recent dry
seasons were only part of the "cli-
matic cycle" and probably would
not continue as unfavorable.

Detailed study of the Arapahoe
glacier reveals that the great ice
sheet has retreated 40 feet within
the last 22 years. Corresponding
loss is shown on others, large and
small, Professor Henderson says.
