COAST AFTER BOXING BOUTS

California's 12-Round Law Is Expected to Break Up Monopoly in East.

NEW YORK (By the Associated Press)—New York, and the metropolitan district which has been the boxing world's Mecca for several years, faces the prospect of having its monopoly broken if the new California law, providing for 12-round bouts, instead of the restricted 10-round to the ring rule in the east.

California, where pugilism flourished in former days, has restricted bouts to four rounds of six, a limit which served to keep away many of the high-class pugilists, most performers and eliminated the chance of championships.

Already a number of coast boys have started westward on the "prospecting" expedition in the hope of securing a license to fight in California. Leonard, the world champion boxer, is expected to arrive in Los Angeles, promoters for a 12-round title bout there in February against an opponent yet to be selected.

Tex Rickard and other metropolitan promoters, however, do not view with alarm the prospect of a new era in boxing in California, where promoters are reported to be planning the erection of a gymnasium to boom state affairs.

Several decades ago boxing was at its height in California, witnessing many notable fights and producing many prominent figures. James J. Corbett, former heavyweight champion, was born in San Francisco and started his ring career there, as did another heavyweight title holder, Jim Jeffries.

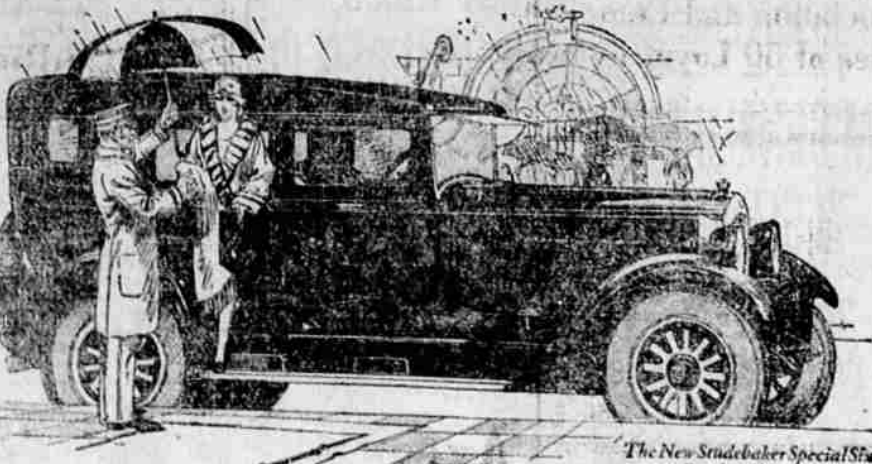
Jeffries fought Fitzsimmons at San Francisco in 1892 after he had won the title from him three years before in the east. Among other historic encounters the famous fight in which Jack Johnson knocked out Stanley Ketchel, occurred at Colma, Cal., in 1905, and Johnny Kilbuck won the featherweight title from Abe Attell at Vernon, Cal., in 1912.

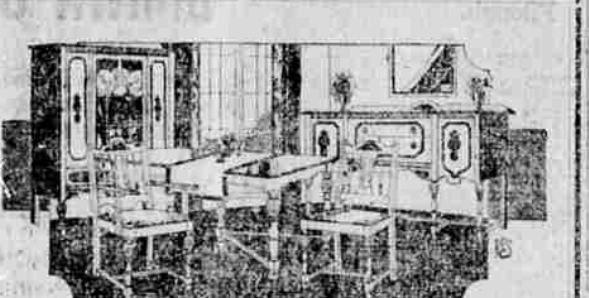
