

NEW CAPITAL IS GOING UP

LA GRANGE (AP)—Despite unforeseen obstacles and many delays incident to the great war, the work of raising the new Indian capital at Delhi has gone steadily on, and latest reports to the Indian office indicate that the first of the new buildings will be occupied by the end of next year.

This will be realized one of the greatest building achievements of modern times. The new Indian capital is rising from a desolate and barren waste. The present English mission, as King-Emery in 1912, announced the decision to transfer the capital of India from Calcutta to Delhi, not the old city of that name, but an entirely new municipality to be built on a reclaimed desert outside and beyond the older settlement.

It was in 1912 that the town planning committee reported in favor of the so-called Bahadri site, beyond old Delhi, although the intervening year of war and reconstruction have doubled the expense of the original project, which will cost at least \$45,000,000 and many more millions in years to come, the work has never once been suspended since it was started.

The principal architect of the new Delhi is Sir Edwin Lutyens, who plans to make it the greatest architectural achievement. Associated with the Indian architect, Mr. B. B. Rowland, and a team of other architects, Lutyens has designed the new Indian capital in the Bahadri site, which is a vast plain of 1,000 acres, and is to be built on a hillside.

Sir Edwin Lutyens and his associates are engaged by a week not only to which Major Lutyens achieved in laying out the city of Washington, each was given the task of preparing plans for a city to be built from the very beginning. In the scheme for the Indian capital, the government house will occupy a pivotal position in the municipality not unlike that which the capital holds in Washington.

The parliament buildings at Delhi will be less ambitious. Present expectations are that they will be ready for occupancy early in 1925. Brick and white marble are the materials used in constructing the new Delhi. Architecturally the style is classical, with skillful blending and adaptation of oriental domes, minarets and arcades.

The government buildings constitute only part of the new city. Included in the original plan are some 1,000 houses for government officers of all ranks and 1,000 more for the Indian staff. The beginning of the new city is being laid out with the necessary public utilities, are being constructed with ample provision for recreation grounds such as cricket and football fields.

Churches and public assembly halls are contemplated and ultimately, but this may be far in the future, a fully equipped university plant, will serve as the capstone of the great undertaking. The rate at which all these schemes can be realized depends wholly upon financial exigencies.
