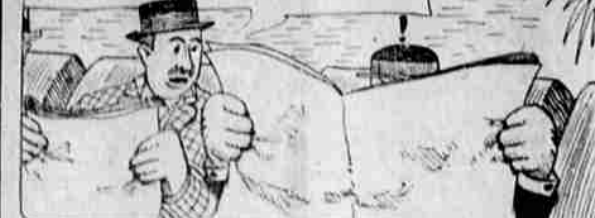

Scientist Denies That Sun Spots Are Cause Of the Earthquakes

BERNSELEY, Cal. (AP)—Four that earthquakes may result from the accumulation of spots on the sun is without scientific basis, according to W. F. Meyer, associate professor of astrophysics at the University of California.

The sun spots, which have been causing much speculation lately are under continual observation at the university and at other observatories.

Professor Meyer said: "Although these spots are constantly appearing together and breaking up to form new ones, the total area is not increasing to any appreciable amount. As far as we know, they have nothing to do with earthquakes on the earth or with any weather conditions in any respect. The only noticeable effect is on the auroral displays at the Pole and in certain magnetic storms, which sometimes interfere slightly with telegraphy."
