Such is the locale of "The Marriage Cheat," a first National

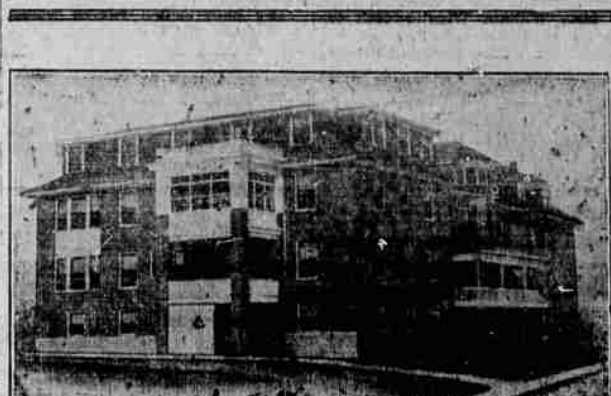
