Maple Sugar Brings Profits To Farmers of Canada
OTTAWA, Ont. (AP) — Maple trees in Canada produced sugar and syrup to the value of \$5,991,141 in 1924, according to a report issued by the dominion department of agriculture. This was the highest return in ten years. Sixty thousand farmers in the four eastern provinces were engaged in the maple sugar industry this year, according to the report, and only one-half of the available sugar maples in this area were made productive. Stimulation of the industry through government encouragement, establishment of schools for practical instruction in Quebec and Ontario and protection of maple trees, it is expected, will greatly increase the output next year. Maple groves, the report points out, are a profitable side-line for the farmers of eastern Canada.

ZEPPELINS NO LONGER ARE SEEN OVER GERMANY

FRIEDRICHSHAFEN (AP) — Twenty Zeppelin plants have been destroyed since the end of the war under the terms of the Treaty of Versailles, and Friedrichshafen alone remains as a reminder of a time when a Zeppelin was as common a sight in Germany as an airplane along the aerial mail routes of the United States.

Zeppelin stations were distributed all over Germany, and there was even one in Bulgaria, which served as the point of operations in the Balkan theater of the world war. Each station belonged to the government, and were used exclusively for military purposes. The largest of these was at Cuxhaven. It included one hangar with a turn-table arrangement which enabled Zeppelins to land safely even during a storm.

Among the centers where the Zeppelin company owned private stations were Düsseldorf, Potsdam, Frankfurt, Hanover and Bremen. The centers included upon their

WATER SUPPLY FOUND

THE DALLES, Ore. — They found sufficient water to irrigate 20,000 acres of land in Wasco county, which might be obtained through a system of storage reservoirs, members of an investigation party, headed by W. S. Nelson, executive secretary of the local chamber of commerce, reported after a week spent in the mountains, most of the time in snow. Further development of the project to secure following a meeting of the chamber when the investigators will make a report and a complete plan may be adopted.

West Indian Oil Flows Steadily

PORT-OF-SPAIN, Trinidad, B. W. I. (AP) — The petroleum industry of Trinidad, started 19 years ago, has shown an increase from 288,934 gallons in 1923 to 198,786,531 gallons in 1924. The total production during this period of time has been more than 833,000,000 gallons. Only twice has the steady increase in production been arrested, in 1915-16 and in 1919.

The exportation of crude and refined oil in 1923, amounted to 85,126,467 gallons.

Many Resolutions Are Placed Before A. F. O. L.

(Continued from Page 1.)

John L. Lewis, president of the United Mine Workers, as secretary of labor, to succeed James J. Davis, in the new cabinet of President Coolidge, was embodied in a resolution submitted by R. C. Bonney, representing the Order of Railway Telegraphers. The matter was referred to the committee on resolutions.

A federal department of education, with a cabinet member at its head and federal appropriations of \$100,000,000 annually for its work, would be demanded of congress under a resolution from F. G. Stecker, a representative of the American Federation of Teachers.

Assistance for striking miners in district 17 of West Virginia and district 23 of Kentucky was solicited in a resolution submitted by Fred Mooney, district president of the United Mine Workers.

A third resolution, dealing with political policies, introduced by R. B. Bonney of the Order of Railway Telegraphers, asked the convention to endorse and approve the position taken by labor in the campaign of 1924.

"We endorse and approve," said the resolution, "the position taken by labor in its concerted acts by the executive committee and officers in the campaign of 1924, and pledge our future support along the same lines, in accordance with the constitution, supporting the friends of labor, regardless of their political affiliations."

"To accomplish such purpose the A. F. O. L. will sponsor no new party at this time, but will continue, as in the past, upholding the right and condemning the wrong, aiding its friends wherever they may be found, at the same time calling upon every member and friend of organized labor to join in selection of men who will stand with the masses in their fight for freedom, justice, democracy and human progress."

Grading Contracts Awarded

HOOD RIVER, Ore. — The contract for grading a three-mile stretch of the North Bank highway, from the Skamania county line west toward Washington, Wn., was awarded the last week, according to Underwood and Clark, folk visiting here, to the Triangle Construction company. The cost of the work was placed at \$99,122.18. The new stretch of road will carry the Evergreen highway around Cape Horn.
