They are no longer seen with heavy stuff in bronze, over the police, and this is taken as a sure sign that conditions generally are again becoming normal.

The four bronze statues surrounding one fountain and the bronze girl with a bird under one arm, guarding another, located in one of the city's centers and which form the object of daily admiration of numerous children, have been returned to their pedestals.

The little copper cupids and angels, brass bell handles and bronze plates, either stolen or removed for safety's sake from public buildings and churches, gradually are being put in place again, and this has helped to give confidence to the public that Germany is very rapidly getting back to normalcy.
