England Turns to Tides To Supply Electricity

LONDON (AP)—A \$150,000,000 project to use the tidal rise in the River Severn for the production of electrical power will be undertaken in the spring by the British government. A committee of electrical experts appointed to investigate the possibilities of harness-

ing the Severn to furnish power for the surrounding district has completed a report in which it recommended that the work be undertaken. The project has been favored by British engineers for several years and it is expected will lead to the erection of hydro-electric plants on most of the rivers of England affected by the tides.
