TROJANS GET EDGE IN DOPE

Syracuse and H. S. C. to Battle for Honors Saturday; Teams Are Well Matched.

LOS ANGELES — Two of the most evenly matched eleven in the country are expected to furnish Southern California football fans with one of the greatest games played anywhere this season when Syracuse university and the University of Southern California meet here in their intercollegiate classic, December 6.

Although the great Orange eleven was rated as one of the three most powerful teams turned out in the far east this year, the dope sheet rates the Trojans far from underdog position in the east-west struggle.

Each team played nine games this season. Syracuse finished the season with one defeat, and one tied contest. The University of Southern California was defeated twice, West Virginia Wesleyan defeated the Orange cohorts on a break, while Pittsburg's strong team managed to battle the Syracuseans to a 7 to 7 draw.
