RAIL CREEK CABIN DEATH MYSTERIOUS

sure it was an accident. The two Melson boys did not explain the shooting and said they were mystified as to the facts. They and their father were questioned at length and Mr. Murray, Mr. Booth and District Attorney

Mrs. Wilson and the jurors tried to figure it out. Mr. Wilson who had visited the cabin with Mr. Murray made a drawing of the interior of the cabin, showing the location of the stove, table, bed room and partitions, all of which only made the situation more incomprehensible.

Gun Fired Table High.

The supposition was that the gun had been leaning against a door frame, in the bed room and that the movement of the men in the

living room had jarred it down, and as the muzzle struck the wall, the gun was supposed to have been standing so far from the partition that its muzzle could not have hit the partition as it fell. Also if the muzzle had struck this partition, the gun at the instant would have been pointed at an upward angle, whereas the charge swept the table from above. The hole in the wall was higher than the table.

Clearly, the gun had not been standing on the floor and had not tipped over against the dividing partition. The range of the shot indicated that the gun had been held nearly level, a little higher than the table and pointing a trifle downward. Apparently some person had held the gun.

At the hospital, Hickman told physicians and attendants that the boys were in the bedroom handling the gun before the fatal shot was fired. This statement was not introduced at the inquest.

Gun Easily Shot

Not one of the survivors of the party of four who entered the cabin went into the bed room where the gun was fired, before it was fired, according to their stories. They said they knew nothing as to its position until it was found lying on the floor. The gun was a one barrel weapon, hammerless without a safety catch. It was tried afterward and was found to be extremely sensitive on the trigger. Hickman had borrowed the gun from Ralph Spray, who had come to the cabin previously intending to stay with him. Hickman also had a loaded rifle and carried a hunting knife strapped on.

Hickman was 35 years old and unmarried. He was born in Virginia and came to the county about 1911 and herded sheep most of the time he worked. For several months he had done little and had been in Joseph most of the time. He was in the service and was an intelligent, friendly man who was well liked. He was a member of the L. O. O. F. lodge of Joseph. His father, H. N. Hickman of Surgeville, Tenn. wired directions that he should be buried here and his funeral was held yesterday at the undertaking rooms and burial was in the Enterprise cemetery.

ENFORCING PROHI LAW A BIG TASK

new laws which were enacted to compel observance to the liquor laws. To meet this situation, the department has been invoking, in such cases as the facts warrant, the use of internal revenue, customs and tariff laws.

In the division handling anti-trust laws, the department has been engaged in the last year in working mainly toward the solution of two major problems, the report said. One of them has to do with selection of cases for prosecution involving organization of trade associations, and in these it has been found that most of the trade associations are entirely legitimate of great value to their members, although others have been found to be in the "gray zone" while a third group has been found to be entirely outside the law. Final determination of legal status involved in these cases will carry the law for all, the Attorney General believed.

Second Problem. The second problem involves application of the anti-trust laws to restraint of trade and monopolies based upon the acquisition and holding of patents. The effort in this phase of the work also has

been to obtain cases that will clarify the law and remove doubt. Mr. Stone renewed recommendations made by previous Attorneys General for enactment of amendment of many laws to simplify enforcement. He favored this for the reason that many of them yet are subject to judicial construction, and until that is done neither the public nor the department can know definitely the meaning.

There should be statutes, the report declared, making it a crime for a single individual to attempt to commit any crime against the government. He asked for explicit legal authority for the presence of stenographers in grand jury rooms and for amendment to the bankruptcy laws making it a crime to conceal assets involved in bankruptcy proceedings. He also said there should be a federal statute to deal with the crime of assaulting or killing a federal officer and another extending punishment for the sending of letters threatening bodily harm through the United States mails.
