RADIO COMPASS PROVES VALUABLE TO NAVIGATION

WASHINGTON (AP)—Tests of a new radio ship compass on the last voyage of the shipping board liner President Pierce gave signal proof of its value to navigation.

The master of the President Pierce reported to the radio division of the board that when his ship was leaving Hongkong for Shanghai in typhoon weather, he lost his bearing and was unable to find the position of his ship through a radio signal sent out by the President Hayes, then in sight of the Keelha light. The use of the device then and later on the same trip saved the President Pierce 24 hours, the skipper reported.

NEW PLYMOUTH COW WINS CHAMPIONSHIP FOR IMAHO

CHICAGO (AP)—Idaho's new champion Holstein cow for production of both milk and butter in 10 months as a senior two-year-old is Edna Lyons Topsy of the Alloys Schuyler herd at New Plymouth. Her record is 15,682.2 pounds of milk containing 415.2 pounds butterfat, equal to 519 pounds butter, according to the advanced registry department of the Holstein-Friesian association of America.
