BALL SESSION TO BE TODAY

NEW YORK (By the Associated Press)—One of the stormiest baseball seasons on record, with Commissioner Landis and President Johnson at the center of a controversy that has gathered increased vigor ever since the world's series and Doherty-Cotton bribery scandal, was in prospect Monday night on the eve of the annual major league meetings.

The National League, at its session Tuesday is expected to take the first important step by adopting resolutions pledging the senior circuit's unqualified support to Commissioner Landis, ignoring his action in handling the scandal and by inferring at least, condemning the attacks made upon the veteran judge by Johnson.

The American League's annual gathering is slated for Wednesday and there were strong indications that Johnson would face another fire, directed by members of his own organization. Clark Griffith, president of the Washington club, has disclosed that a majority of American league managers intend to adopt resolutions supporting Landis and condemning the leader's antagonism to Landis, together with Johnson's failure to attend the world's series.

Assured of virtually unanimous National League backing and apparently well supported in American league ranks, Landis, in the opinion of observers, was strongly entrenched for the final act of the drama, scheduled for the joint major league meeting Thursday.

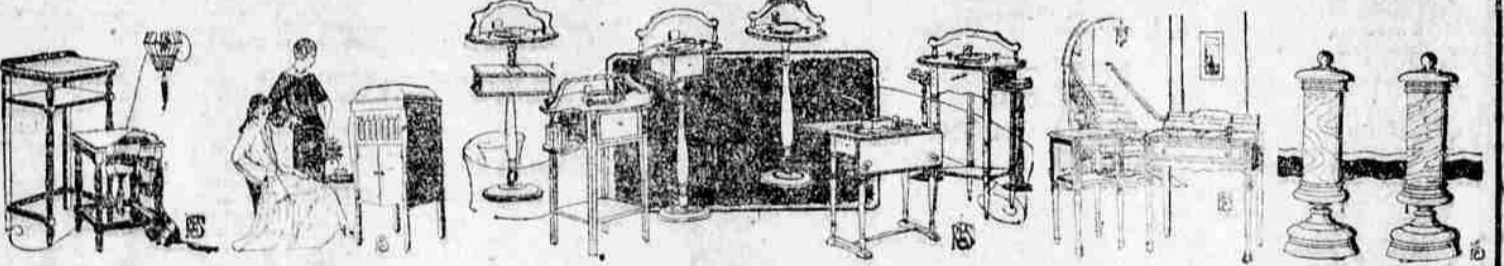
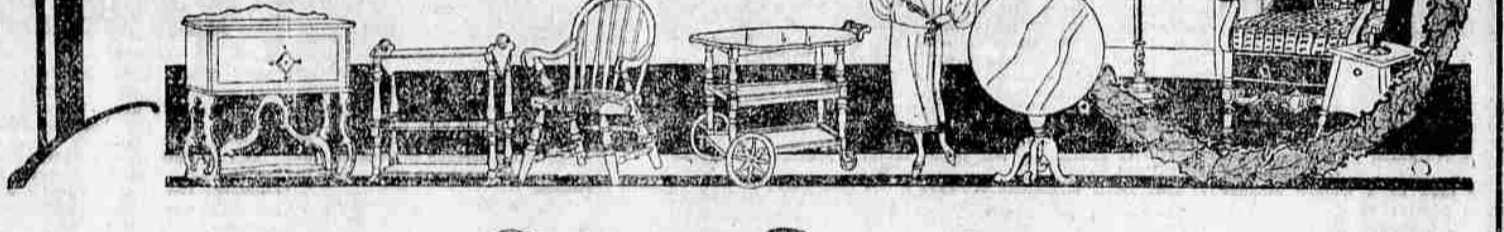

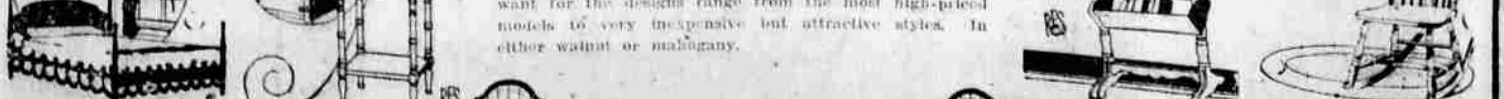
