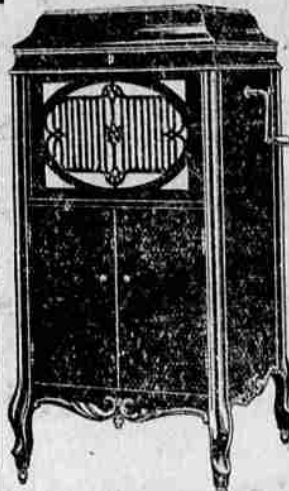
### England Raises \$11,000 to Retain Historic Letters

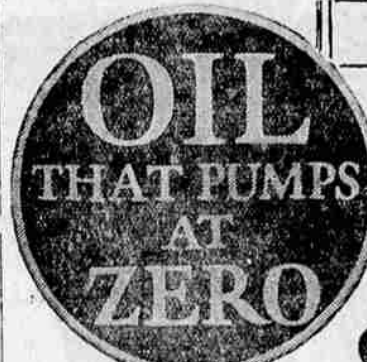
