

WEATHER MEN VISIT ISLAND

RIO DE JANEIRO, Brazil (AP)—

The steamer Frederico Narduzzi changed slowly on to an uncharted island in the southwestern Atlantic. The picked passengers and a cargo of scientific apparatus and a party of weather men, the charter members and animals of an expedition on the rocky, volcanic island of Trinidad, 440 miles east of Brazil.

After the boat drops anchor in front of Portuguese Beach, Jose Caetano Pontes will take charge of the Brazilian possession as military commander. Homes will be built, roads planted, a fishing industry started, and a radio station erected.

The colonizing idea originated in 1922, when the chief of the Brazilian Meteorological Service, Dr. Augusto Faria, promised his colleagues in the meeting in Holland of the International Meteorological Conference of Directors, that Brazil would share in developing a world wide weather forecasting service. The expedition to Trinidad, which is not to be confined with the Trinidad of the West Indies, is the first step of the Brazilian government in the fulfillment of this promise.

Weather conditions are to be recorded daily from Trinidad to Rio de Janeiro. Three additional stations are later to be built. These four are to be located on islands in a high pressure area in mid-ocean, and their daily reports will change the weather experts at Rio to much more accurately predict the route of South Atlantic wind and weather.

British Labor Party Finds Recompense in Million More Votes

LONDON, (AP)—Labor is far from discouraged over the result of the recent election. Although it lost nearly 50 seats, the party gained more than 1,000,000 new voters, demonstrating that the Socialist movement in British politics is not only alive and kicking, but growing rapidly as well.

After all, the sweeping change in party strength in the House of Commons, which the election brought about, was due greatly to what Lloyd George and others have called an unjust and undemocratic franchise in the British electoral system. In three-sided contests the existing system permits the election of a candidate by a minority of the voters, as the high man of the three wins.

A year ago the bulk of the three-party fighting went to Labor and against the Conservatives. This time the reverse happened. The Conservatives polled less than half the votes cast by the populace, but won more than two-thirds of the seats. For every seven votes that were Conservative, Labor got five. Yet more than 400 Conservative candidates were elected, while Labor won less than 150 seats. The Liberal strength shrunk at the polls from more than 4,000,000 to less than 3,000,000, and in the House this middle party withered to less than 10 members.

In consequence of the strange

harvest that sprung from the votes of the nation, the advocates of electoral reform are pushing more and more vocal chords indignantly. The movement for introducing proportional representation has taken on fresh vigor. The Proportional Representation Society has pointed out that had the system in use, the Tories would have only three-fourths of their present parliamentary members; Labor would hold more than 200 seats instead of 155, and the Liberals would have 100 members instead of a mere omnibus handful of less than 40.

There are no indications, however, that electoral reforms are high. The Conservatives are satisfied, and it would hardly be human

nature for them to push through reforms that would weaken their parliamentary position.

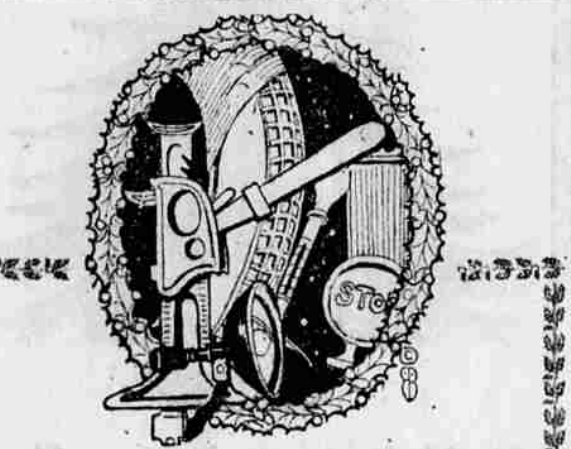

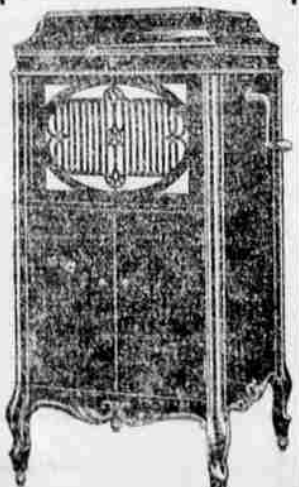
