water, no insurance; Hemenway & Moser clear store, \$7000 loss from water and smoke, covered by insurance.

Prescription Files Save.
Dr. E. S. Owen, head of the Boise Optical company, said early Tuesday morning his big loss would be in his prescription files, but investigation of his office showed the flames had escaped the flames. Practically all of the damage to Doctor Owen's office was by smoke and water and amounted to \$5000, covered by insurance.

The Dawson Candy Shop, on Main street, owned by George P. Dawson, suffered a \$9000 loss through both fire and water.

Busy All Day.
All day firemen were kept busy on the scene with hose and equipment in case the blaze should break out anew. Three or four times during the day it was necessary to put water on small flames. Tuesday night three watchmen were put on to protect the contents of the building and watch for further fires.

No plans will be formulated for the rebuilding of the building, according to Frank Noble, until the matter is taken up by the board of trustees of the Noble estate. The present walls may be used provided they are not declared unsafe by the city building inspector, he said.

MAN BURNED
MOUNTAIN HOME—Trapped in a pantry in the lonely Berry ranch house outside of Mountain Home, Thomas Zachary, 60, met death in a fire which totally destroyed the building late Monday night. A coroner's jury, impaneled Tuesday by Elmer Ottenheimer, Elmore county coroner, found that Zachary met death "by means of an accidental fire, origin unknown."

Neighbors are far apart in the district where the Berry ranch stands. Zachary, the caretaker, had been living on the place alone. Monday he was not feeling well.
