Sirens May Save Orchards.

SYDNEY, N. S. W. (AP)—The Irrigation Commission of New South Wales has made available a sum of money to undertake a unique experiment. It is proposed to make tests with marine signaling apparatus to see if it will be effective in scaring starlings and other birds from vineyards and orchards in the irrigation area. The apparatus consists of a siren used by ships in distress, and would be operated electrically from the farm, the siren itself being placed among the trees or vines.
