

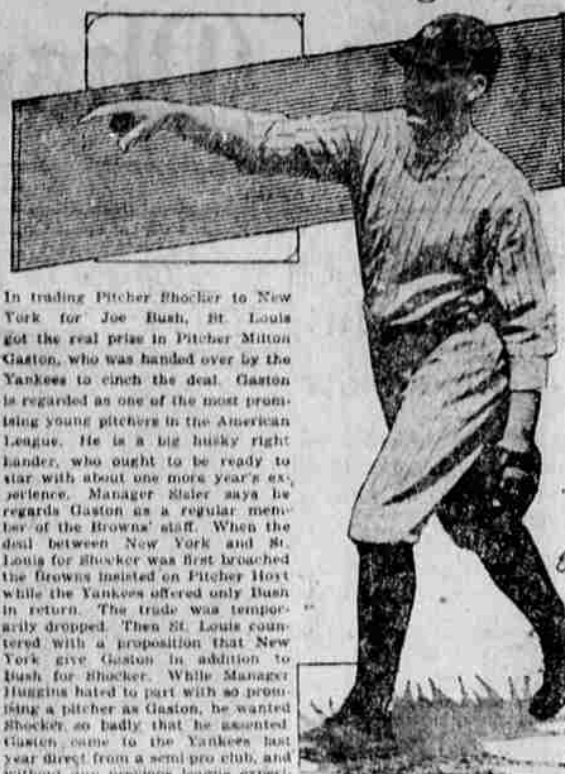

Czechs' Pocketbooks Too Thin To Satisfy Their Artistic Desires

PRAGUE (AP)—The second sale by auction within a few months of art treasures of the collection of the former Hungarian magnate, Paulffy, was held recently. Although a number of rare treasures passed into new hands, the sale was by no means satisfactory.

Foreign buyers were not invited for two reasons—the desire to keep the treasures within the country and to ascertain the financial capacity and interest in art among the Czechoslovakian people.
