### "We All Have Blood Pressure," Is Claim

"Doctor, have I any blood pressure?" This is a question commonly asked of doctors, says Dr. A. W. Hildre, writing in the December Number of the Oseopathic Magazine.

"Everybody has blood pressure. The question should be 'How much blood pressure have I?' Let us see, therefore, what we mean by blood pressure.

"Blood pressure is the pressure that is exerted on the blood in the arteries by the heart. It is similar to the pressure exerted in a city water supply by the pump which forces water into the closed system of water pipes. The water is thus distributed throughout the city wherever the ramifications of the water pipes go. There is always some pressure on the water which would not flow at the faucet.

"The water pressure is regulated in such a way that there is a fairly constant force sufficient to meet the demands of the various houses using it. If the pressure were increased much over this amount the pipes might break at their weak joints and considerable damage be done. On the other hand, pressure must not be too low, or water in sufficient quantities cannot be had for the various purposes.

"In the same way that blood pumps the blood into our pipes, the arteries, and so forces it to all parts of the body. The pressure must be carefully controlled so that sufficient blood will reach the various tissues of the body and supply them with nourishment. Similarly, it must not be too high or it will break through the walls of the arteries at their weak points in time of stress or disease. It is this kind of break in an artery in the brain, which produces a stroke or paralysis."
