Pictureque Old Corvette Seen In "Tents of Allah."  
Hundreds of vessels that came into the harbor of San Juan were inspected before the proper one was found for the Sultan's ship in the Encreo Pictures, "The Tents of Allah," starring Monte Blue and Mary Alden. But something was always lacking, until there sailed into port, one day, a ship of a type which there are only two in existence. This is a Spanish corvette, a boat that is a combination of those used by Columbus, which carried much sail and very light draught, and the Yankee clipper, which placed its sails at another angle. A corvette carries more sail, and therefore also more rope, than any other boat.

When producer E. A. MacManus found the corvette it had just returned from its third trip in a year to Spain, making the trip in fifteen days and covering the same route that took Columbus about eight months to make. It is almost impossible, outside of Spain, to get a seafaring man that can handle a corvette. The captain of this particular boat was a wonder and the last of his type of sailors.
