The Danish market is an attractive one for American products," Mr. Prince says, "because of Denmark's increased industrial activities, the high standard of living within the country, and the well maintained purchasing power of its people. These factors, together with the almost complete elimination of some competitive elements, and also a growth of direct commercial intercourse between the two countries, have tended to increase the participation of the United States in the Danish import trade from 10 per cent in 1913 to 15 per cent in 1923. In fact, the United States now follows Germany and Great Britain in order of importance as a supplier of the Danish market."

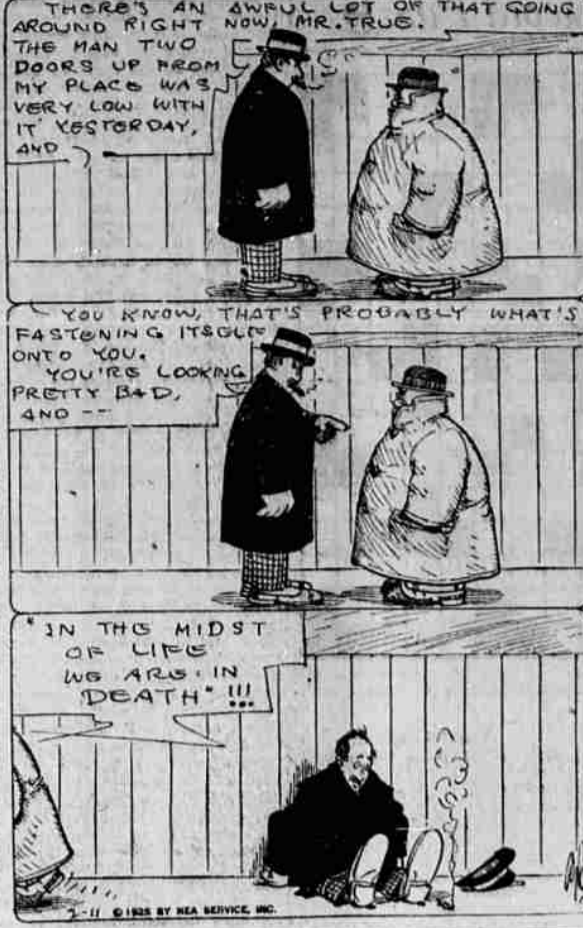
