## Income Tax Facts

Editor's Note—This is the concluding installment of income tax articles published for the past month in the interest of taxpayers and for their benefit.  
 No. 20.  
 When by reason of illness or absence from home, additional time for filing an income-tax return is required, the taxpayer should address to the Commissioner of Internal Revenue, Washington, D. C., a request for an extension. Collectors of internal revenue are not, as under preceding acts, permitted to grant such extensions. The request must be made before the return is due—March 15, 1925, if made on the calendar-year basis—and must contain a full recital of the causes for the delay.  
 An extension of time for filing the return does not extend the time for payment of the tax or any installment thereof unless so specified in the extension. As a condition of granting the extension, the commissioner may require the submission of a tentative return and estimate of the amount of the tax, and the payment of at least one-fourth of the estimated amount. made on the usual return form, plainly marked "tentative" at the top, contains a statement of the estimated amount of tax believed to be due, and be properly executed. No other data need be given. Tentative returns will not be accepted unless permission is obtained previous to filing. A copy of the authority to file the tentative return must be attached thereto.  
 Where a taxpayer files a tentative return within the period of the extension granted him, the complete return when filed is subject to the penalties prescribed for delinquency.  
 Except in the case of a taxpayer who is abroad, no extension will be granted for more than six months.

 "Veterans of the World War who have not submitted applications for their bonuses are urged by L. C. O. E. Andrews, city recruiting officer, U. S. A., to do so at once. The importance of applying at the earliest possible date is urged upon the veterans by Col. Andrews who stated: "The War Department is daily receiving cases in which veterans who thought themselves in the best of health have died or have been killed by accident without having submitted their applications for adjusted compensation. Their widows and children, many of them in needy circumstances, need in such cases cash to the amount of the adjusted credit, an amount equal to approximately one-third only of that he would have received in one payment, in cash had the veteran made application prior to death. For instance, should a veteran who served overseas for a period entitling him to the maximum amount of adjusted service credit of \$425, die without
