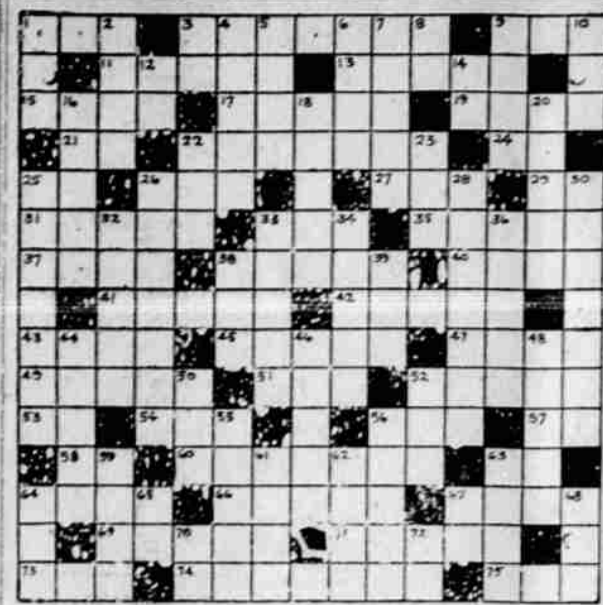

JEW TO HAVE OWN HOMELAND

The Jews have been without a homeland for more than 2500 years," stated S. H. Tordjian, who spoke here yesterday on "Jews Rebuilding Palestine—The Reason." He continued: "Their last king, Zedekiah, was deposed in 606 B. C. and the prophecies of the Bible indicate that seven times or 2520 years, should pass over their heads before they would be rehabilitated in the land given to Abraham and his posterity and receive again their national power."

He then declared that since 1913 great strides have been made toward reclaiming the Holy Land for the ancient people.

"The restoration of Israel does not mean that commercialism is to be enthroned, nor that higher civilization is to be dominant factor in the new government to be established in Palestine. Not every one who claims to be a Jew is a Jew. A Jew from Jehovah's viewpoint is one who is the offspring of Abraham and has the faith of Abraham. The restoration of the Jews at this time is by divine favor and nothing can stop it," the speaker declared.

King of Siam Seems to Prefer Comfort on Wheels to Speed. LONDON (AP)—A motor car with a trailer, the whole valued at \$25,000, is to be presented to the king of Siam by the members of the Siam royal household, according to word received here.

There are several unusual features connected with the gift. The driver sits in the open, as in an ordinary car, but behind him in a compartment "hibe" room set aside for his own use. There is also a dining room and sitting room, luxuriously furnished, and a bath room.

The trailer has a bed room with one bed and a sitting room with two beds folding up against the wall when not in use. Both cars are furnished throughout in polished mahogany. The weight of the car is nine tons and of the trailer seven tons, and the combination cannot exceed a speed of 14 miles an hour.
