RELIC FAKERS ARE EXPOSED

Five Alleged Skulls of John Wilkes Booth, Assassin of Lincoln, on Exhibition Now.

SPRINGFIELD, Ill. (AP)—Five alleged skulls of John Wilkes Booth, assassin of President Lincoln, are on exhibition in the United States and twenty 'Booths' have died, according to Herbert Wells Fay, custodian of Lincoln's tomb here...

Those who wish to make money out of the hoax or to create cheap notoriety, are the only ones who dispute the historical record of Booth's death in a barn at the Garrett farm...

The version of Booth's death accepted by the custodian of the victim's tomb is as follows: "John Wilkes Booth studied his paraders for 11 days. He was fed by Thomas A. Jones in the mountains in a grove along the Potomac river...

Booth refused, saying he would 'die in the last ditch.' The barn was set afire. "Boston Corbett, a sergeant, saw Booth through a crack and discharged a shot at him. He was brought out by Corbett's men and died in three hours...

Booth was buried under a federal prison and an accurate, detailed report made on position and condition as required. Later Edwin Booth, actor-brother of the slayer, obtained an order allowing him to see the body, hoping that a mistake had been made...

The Garden

Starting a Garden Under Glass

Vegetables which need a hotbed for an early start are tomatoes, peppers, egg plants, cabbages, cauliflowers, and head lettuce varieties. If big onions are wanted, onion seed should be given an early start for transplanting...

All of the annuals for the garden which require a long season or are desired early bloom, such as asters and zinnias, may well be grown in the hotbed along with salivates, stocks, heliotropes and other bed-ding plants. Pansies for early bloom may be had ready to lift in bloom and bud by May by the use of the hotbed...

From three weeks to a month after hotbed seeds are started, depending on the earliness of the date, the cold frame may be used to much the same series of seeds that are placed in the hotbed. While there is frost in the air which would be fatal to tender subjects, such as the tomato, they may be planted in the cold frame...

American Magnates Pursue Invasion of British Film Field

LONDON (AP)—The moaning and wringing of hands over the sad state of the British movie picture film business waxes louder day by day. Perhaps the public eye catches, but it shows no inclination to come crawling into the hundreds of British theaters where American films are run off almost exclusively, year in and year out.

The British film makers cast an envious eye at Hollywood, and they lift their voices, fervently hoping to catch the ears of both government and the public, and protest that even Eastland's own dominions and colonies are being Americanized by the subtle propaganda contained in the celluloid products of the studios of California and New York. Lost their arguments fall on deaf ears. The very life blood of the empire, is brought into play. It would seem that trade has broken itself of the habit of following flags; these days it follows the film. There is a very active campaign on to have the Baldwin government slap a heavy tax on foreign films, and help the tottering movie magnates of this country until their business grows up and becomes steady on its feet. The government has so far kept silent upon its intentions, if any, as regards the movies.

Meanwhile dollar-baden magnates of the movie breeze in from Broadway, one after another, and whisk around the British Isles, building up defenses against competition from other sources and bolstering their English business.
