MEMPHIS, Tenn. (NEA Special)—One year ago, Clarence Saunders, deposed head of Piggly Wiggly, moved from his palatial home to a small apartment in a hotel. He was bankrupt after a year's battle lasting six months.

Clarence Saunders then made his now famous prophecy: "In three years I will have made three million dollars. I can make a million dollars easily."
