PLASTIGRAMS

LAND PLASTER AIDS ALFALFA

Four acres of land plaster applied to the alfalfa fields of Union county last year increased the yield on 2150 acres about one ton per acre, reports J. G. Avey, county agricultural agent. This material was used for its sulfur content.

Following the discovery in 1913 by the southern Oregon branch experimental station at Talent, that sulfur increases alfalfa yield, the spread of this practice was accelerated by farmer-coöperative agent demonstrations in such counties as Klamath, Wasco, Crook, Josephine, Deschutes, Lake and eastern Umatilla use of sulfur is estimated more than a million pounds of that material were used in these counties alone last year. The most rate of application is 100 pounds an acre. One application is good for two years on the average.

S. E. Miller, prominent Union county stockman, has had excellent success in using sulfur fertilizer on alfalfa. It gave him three crops of hay one year when half of the same field had not produced any last year.

Sulfur has practically "made" the alfalfa industry in Wasco county, reports C. W. Ditzel, county agent, and has been worth a quarter of a million dollars to that county. Each year has seen an increase in the quantity ordered. Sixteen tons were used in 1921, and 50 tons in 1924.

Three tons of hay from cultured alfalfa and one ton from uncultured portions of the field are reported by H. B. Christensen who lives in the Goose Lake valley, Lake county.

Although many farmers apply sulfur in the spring it has been found that fall application results in an immediate increase in yield the following summer.

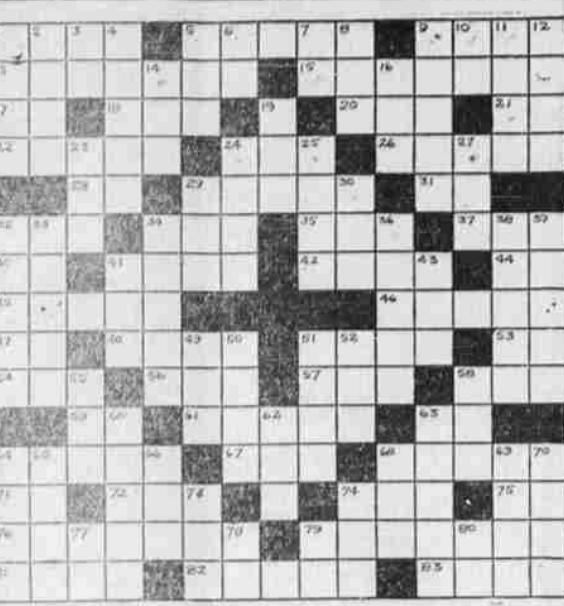
