



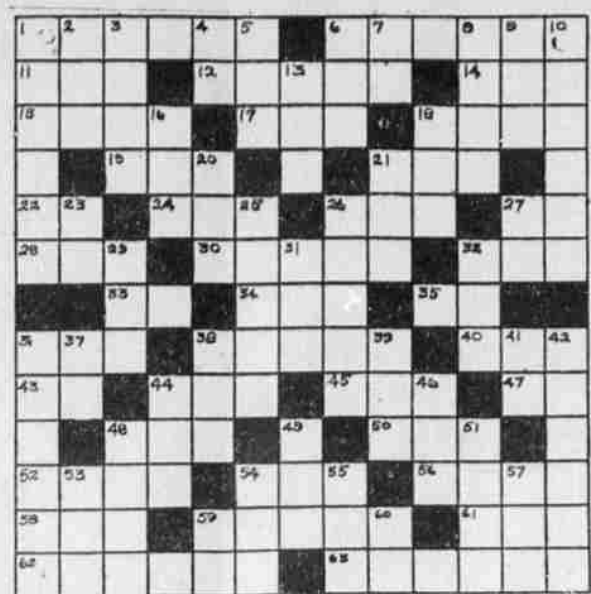

English Cradles Empty Despite Many Weddings

LONDON (AP)—The blight of unemployment, which has kept more than a tenth of Britain's workfolk idle for five years, has not dulled the darts from Cupid's bow. Just as many marriages were performed last year for every thousand people in England and Wales as in 1923.

Although marriage is as popular as ever, people are bringing fewer and fewer babies into the world. Last year the birth rate dropped down to 18.7 a thousand, the lowest level ever reached in the country, excepting the abnormal years in the closing half of the great war.

The provisional figures for last year's vital statistics, issued by the registrar-general, report 739,285 and 473,270 deaths. The births were almost 30,000 fewer than in 1923, and the deaths almost 20,000 more.

Both the death rate and the infant mortality rate were slightly higher last year than in 1923.

Holland Not Alarmed By Colonies' Actions

THE HAGUE, Holland (AP)—People in Holland are paying a good deal of attention just now to reports of communist activities in their eastern possessions.

The latest news from the colonies is to the effect that closer supervision has been ordered throughout the East Indies archipelago over all political gatherings, which no young person under 18 years of age are allowed to attend, 18 being considered a ripe age, politically, in the tropics.

M. K. de Graaff, the Dutch minister of colonies, seems, however, to view the position without alarm. In a memorandum to the chamber on the colonial budget

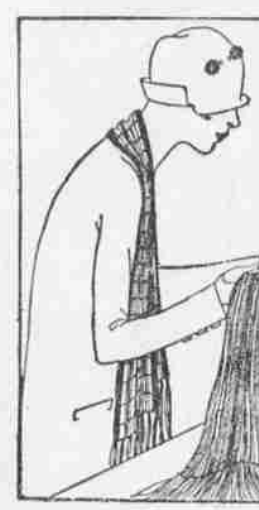
