Turpin, whose porgious countenance, smiling courtesy and deeds of daring made him the most famous of England's highway robbers, has been put on the screen as "Dick Turpin" and as the bold bandit Tom Moe, William Fox star, has been fitted with the most character of his career.

A powerful cast supporting the star, Alie Hale giving a fine impersonation of Turpin's bluff companion regus, Tom King, Kathleen Myers, now attracted for the first time with a leading role in a great picture, is charming as "Alice Brookfield."
