DODGERS WIN IN LONG GAME

SISLER'S RECORD
George Sisler's record of hitting safely one or more times in the first 24 games of the season is a remarkable performance.

It makes it seem that the comeback of the popular leader of the St. Louis Browns is more than a mere flash. New long-hitting streaks have started with the opening of the season as did Sisler's.

In compiling his record of 24 consecutive games in which he hit safely, Sisler drove the ball in all fields.

Last season he dropped most of his hits into left field. This year he is pulling the ball to all sections of the playing territory. No better proof could be offered as to the genuineness of his comeback.

Sisler's 1925 record of 24 games in which he hit safely tops the two best efforts of last season. In the American, Sam Rice hit safely in 23 games in the National, Eddie Houch won 27 straight.

GREAT JOHNSON

That the baseball fan admires the true sportsman, the player who always gives his best, is evidenced wherever the Washington club plays.
