with supplies and equipment until they were themselves out. Lugging their own outfits with them. An arctic expedition needs to keep quiet.

These three men used to spend as much time playing camp and pulling up stakes again, and cooking and hunting as they did on their travels. Finally, they got out to sea and their own outfits and they tried to abandon anything they just set down in the middle of it and cross on a stevedore to death.

Lieutenant Frederick Schwilke, well known in his day, spoke in much the usual tone of Captain Bartlett of the party of the north. As a very young reporter I interviewed him years ago concerning his exploratory work in interior Alaska, then little known.

Emerging from the wilderness on his way to the sea he had crossed the Coast Range by way of the Klondike Pass, later called the Klondike Pass because of the party's horror, were described in a way to make the hair stand on Schwilke's back. He told me that Schwilke told about it like this: "My Indians and I reached the pass at dusk and camped. Next morning we crossed, finding it rather dangerous for a few moments as from some point a mad fall."

Sweden Rich in Water Power

To Electrify All Railroads
The HANXAN Station, CAP—After having used water power for 100 years, Sweden is being visited by Sweden as a water power in their portion both on land and sea. The most recently published statistics show that of all the boats now under construction in Swedish ship yards, more than 90 percent are to be propelled by motors, and on the railways the old-fashioned locomotives are being discarded in favor of electric traction engines or motor trucks. Having no coal and little or no water power, Sweden is rich in time of electricity and its railroads.

In the meantime motor-driven tractors are rapidly replacing the steam engines on shorter hauls. The HANXAN-Name line, for instance, has converted an ordinary American made steamship into a rail-truck capable of carrying three and a half tons of 25 miles an hour. Railroad tracks with electric motors, which have grade and are still more economical, and the less company of America has completed 20 of this type and has ten more under construction.
