**Frogs Imbedded in Cement For Years Are Found Alive**

OKANOGAN, Wash. (AP).—Several green frogs, imprisoned in cement gravel, were set free when a road crew made a cut in a country road near here. They were found firmly imbedded three feet below the surface of the old highway. The frogs showed considerable animation on being released, giving no signs of the inconvenience caused by several years imprisonment.

Trevor Kincaid, professor of biology in the University of Washington, declared the existence of frogs imprisoned in cement over a period of years quite possible, though he said no scientific data had been gathered on the point.

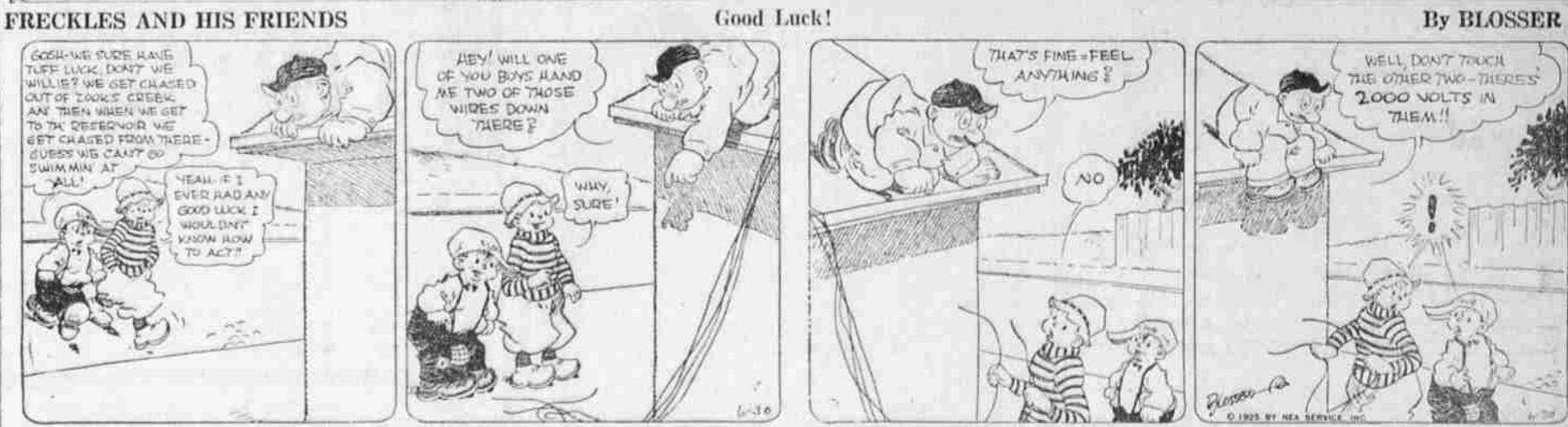
