#### Waseda University's Modern Library To Be Completed Soon

TOKYO (AP)—The new library building of Waseda University, which will be the second modern building since the earthquake of 1923, is expected to be completed before the end of this year.

The Waseda library was planned by that university's founder, Marquis Okuma, in honor of the accession of the present Emperor of Japan more than a decade ago. The intervening time has been utilized for making plans and for collecting funds for the purpose from Waseda's alumni. Construction was ready to begin at the time of the great earthquake, which, however, delayed it until last spring.

The new structure was designed by Dr. Naito and Dr. Sato of the Waseda faculty, and covers nearly 1400 square yards. The main reading room is two stories in height, and will seat more than 500 persons. That section of the building containing the stacks is five stories high and is so designed that it can be added to as the demand for greater space grows. The original section will accommodate 200,000 books, the university at present having about three-fifths that number. It is equipped with elevator service and all other modern library facilities. The building, which is of steel and concrete, is fireproof throughout, in addition to which there is a special fireproof vault for the more valuable books.

Connected with the library is a one-story building which will contain a student's dining room, an official dining room, a book bindery, a book store, quarters for the librarians, furnace, etc.

## M'MILLAN WILL GO ON THE AIR

CHICAGO (AP)—Radio messages from the Arctic regions have been brought to civilization but not yet the human voice. When the MacMillan-Navy expedition's transmitting stations are set up, one with eleven degrees of the North Pole, it is the addition of Eugene P. McDonald, Jr., chief of radio with the party, to give listeners in a native Eskimos' program as well as have the voice describe what the expedition is seeing and doing.

It was an undertaking in which there was not too much confidence, because it had never been done and only limited observations could be made last year when radio was first tried in the Arctic. From that experience, however, and since low wave length equipment has been highly developed for this expedition, the chance of voice transmitting was considerably increased.

As all transmitting from the expedition will be on low waves, which the standard radio set is incapable of picking up, should the voice come back station WJAZ at Chicago will hit it and rebroadcast on a higher wave length so everyone can hear. Either of the polar broadcasting stations are equipped to send on a wave as low as one meter.

Special arrangements were made for distribution of the news dispatches sent back from the expedition, which first will be received by the National Geographic Society. Features in radio will be handled by the radio staff and announced at the Zenith company here.

### Prehistoric Race Built Big Apartment Houses

TUCSON, ARIZ. (AP)—The Pachuca Bonita, in northwestern New Mexico, is described by Dr. Neil Morton Judd, curator of southwestern archaeology for the National Museum in Washington, as the largest prehistoric apartment house on the North American continent.

The Bonita had 300 rooms and money enough to house between 1,200 and 1,500 persons.


Excavations of the pueblo may lead to the discovery of a prehistoric race hitherto unknown, Dr. Judd believes. Traces in the form of pottery, relics, skeletons and hieroglyphic inscriptions are expected to lead to archaeological revelations of the first magnitude.

The Bonita contains evidences of the life and pursuits of the race which, scientists believe, inhabited it thousands of years ago. It covers an area of a little more than three acres. Four stories of the pueblo are standing, and Dr. Judd thinks there may have been a fifth.

Further research into the cave dwelling of southern New Mexico has established the possibility that the Caribed cavern, one of the largest crystal formation caves in the world, once was the meeting place for cave-men of the vicinity. Hieroglyphics, not unlike Chinese characters, were found on the smooth surfaces of the cliffs and in the caves.

Shothole hunters attack only the trees that have been set back by injury enough to form a "sour sap" condition. On boring into such a tree the insects prepare to feed their young grubs by planting in the tunnel a fungus that will grow only in sour sap conditions. The beetles are attracted to trees in this condition and attack them. So the first step in O. A. C. experiment station control is to find the cause of poor vitality in the tree, and to remove it as much as possible. Seriously infested trees should be cut out and burned.

### Canadian National Park Antelope Herd Thrives

CALGARY, ALTA. (AP)—Antelope which were threatened with extinction in Canada have been successfully preserved in Neelum national park. When the preserve was established in 1913 there were only 45 in the herd, the last survivors of the Thibetians, and that once had roamed the prairie. There are now 225 animals in the herd, a gain of 180. How well they breed in captivity is shown by the fact that there was an increase of 95 in 1924 alone.

Antelope once were prized trophies and suffered such ravages in numbers that extinction of the species was in sight. A herd finally was discovered in Southern Alberta and the tract of 2,500 acres on which the animals were feeding was surrounded by a fence of woven wire and all the work was done without disturbing the animals.
