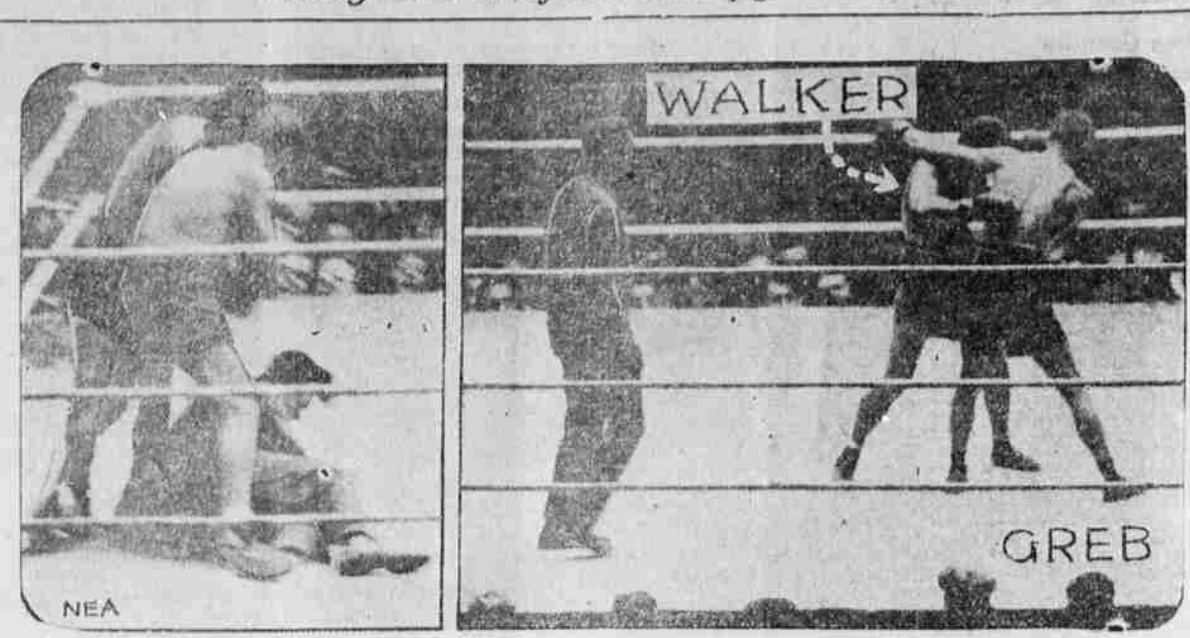
Mr. and Mrs. W. Stringham of Lumber are house guests of Mrs. Stringham's parents, Mr. and Mrs. H. I. Barker.

Irish Children Early Fix Minds
On Getting to U. S., Says Doctor

DUBLIN, (AP)—In evidence before the commission on the state of the Irish language in the Irish speaking districts, Dr. William O'Brien, medical officer of County Galway, said that Irish was seldom used by officials of the local bodies in the county. Very few solicitors were able to converse in Irish and he knew of only one barrister who had mastered the tongue.

He did not believe, he said, that the soil in these western districts was sufficient to maintain the present population which depended a good deal on friends and families in America.

"From the time they leave school at the age of 12 or 13, the poor children of Connemara have their thoughts fixed on America, and how they can get away to it," he declared.

President Ralph Budd of the railway, Secretary David Hilger of the Montana Historical Society and other interested citizens visited the spot late in May and located the old blockhouse bastions and other indications which Mr. Hilger believes will, with the aid of some very detailed descriptions and pictures in the society's library, permit an exact reproduction of the old fort. The owner of nine acres of land which includes the site of

the fort has offered to donate this property if the purpose can be accomplished. The United States Government will be asked to cooperate. It is estimated that the cost will be \$25,000.

A mass meeting, which will be attended by the governors of Montana and North Dakota and by governors of both states has been arranged for July 15 at the site of the fort. It is expected at this meeting to perfect plans for the reconstruction and maintenance of the fort in Montana and North Dakota which are needed for the fulfillment of the plan.

The fort, which was actually a fortified trading post, was established in 1823 by Kenneth McKenzie for the American Fur Company of which he was a member. The site is a short distance above the mouth of the Yellowstone river on the north bank of the Mackay river. The boundary line between Montana and North Dakota runs through the 40-acre tract which is sought for the project.

The original fort was destroyed by fire in 1821, but was rebuilt immediately and extended. In 1831 it was pulled down on order of the commanding officer at Fort Buford, five miles south.
