ONE OF GREATEST When the veteran, Herb Pennock shut out the heavy-hitting Athletics over 15 innings the other day, he turned in one of the premier performances of his long and illustrious career.

Not only did the Yankee hurler blank the Maeks, but over that lengthy stretch he permitted but four base swats, one a triple by Jimmy Dykes that all but brought defeat.

Any gunner holding the Maekmen to but a quartet of swats in 15 sessions is certainly dishing up a real brand of pitching, too. Feats like that aren't popping out very often these days.

In all those 15 frames, Pennock didn't issue a solitary pass, or make a wild pitch either. The Maeks had just two men left on the maeks. Real hurting in every sense of the word.

Frankly, it was one of the best bits of pitching, everything considered, turned in on a major league diamond in quite some time.

THE RECORD GAME. The 1-6 battle didn't quite equal the major league record, however. For back in 1913, Washington and Chicago played an 18-inning contest, the former finally winning by the same count the Yankees whipped the Maeks.

That battle of seven years ago stands as the longest of modern times wherein but a single run was scored. In 1882, Providence trimmed Detroit by a similar count. But that of course was in the so-called "old days."

The longest scoreless game on record in the majors was played by Detroit and Washington on July 16, 1909 at Detroit.

If memory serves correctly, Eddie Summers buried the entire game for the Tigers that hot afternoon. He was opposed by Bob Groom and Dolly Gray. The tilt was finally called on account of darkness.

Seven years later the St. Louis Browns and Boston Red Sox battled through 17 stanzas deadlocked at 0-0.

These are the premier performances insofar as scoreless trays are concerned in major league history.

BRAZILL LEADS COAST BATTERS; HAS 20 HOMERS

SAN FRANCISCO, Cal. (By the Associated Press)—Frank Heall, Seattle third baseman, is again leading the Pacific Coast league batters with an average of .406, unofficial figures, including Saturday's games, show, "Lefty" O'Doul, with the Salt Lake Bees, is a close second with .402, and Paul Waber of the Beas, is next with an average of .400.

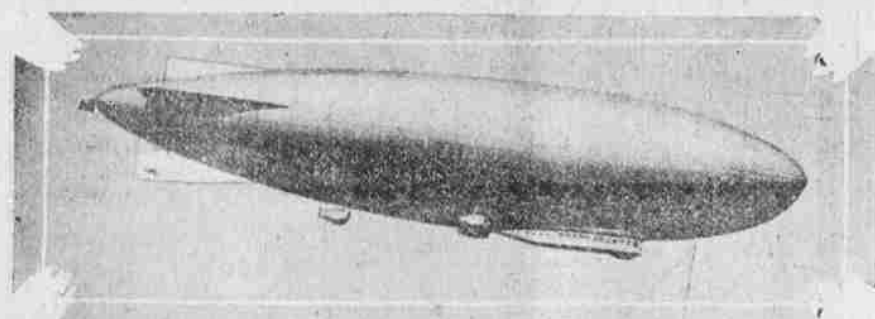

BUFFALO LAD WORLD CHAMP

NEW YORK (AP)—Jimmy Goodrich of Buffalo, N. Y., won the lightweight elimination tournament staged under the auspices of the New York state athletic commission when he scored a technical knockout Monday night over Stanislaus Lozada of Chile in the second round of a 15-round match at the Queensboro Athletic club. Lozada fractured his right ankle in a fall in the first round but pluckily remained in the contest until the white towel of defeat was tossed into the ring after 36 seconds of the second round.

By virtue of this victory Goodrich will be crowned with the world's lightweight championship left vacant by the retirement of Benny Leonard, by the New York athletic commission.

Five times in the first round, Goodrich knocked the Chilean down, simply overwhelming him ely by his superior strength.
