U. S. SPORT MAD BRITON CLAIMS

LONDON (AP)—That universal overseas have gone mad on sport is one of the notes made by Sir Ernest Bain, chairman of the finance committee of the Leeds university, who recently returned from a visit to universities in Canada and the United States.

"I heard of one case," he said "where a town's butcher had been enrolled as a member of the university because he had exceptional ability as a footballer."

Dealing with details of organization of the universities, he notes that in every American university the alumni are well organized and powerful, so powerful as to create difficulty in many cases, as they not only lay down conditions upon which gifts are made to the university but there is an active interference with teaching.

On the question of salaries, after detailing the amount paid to professors, he says it is significant that the individual responsible for sports in all the great universities receives a payment substantially higher than that of any academic member, even including the chancellor.
