LABOR DEMAND AT HIGH PEAK

PORTLAND, Ore., (Special).—Call for hundreds of men to fight forest fires coupled with a continuance of the movement of harvest hands to the wheat fields east of the Cascade have brought about the peak of employment for the year in the Pacific northwest according to H. Employment service headquarters here.

Little change in employment in the timber industry has taken place. The H. service reports, as many logging camps are idle and sawmills are largely on a one shift basis or equipped with one year olds. In the pine country, however, sawmills are operating two and three shifts and the demand for skilled mill help there is at the season's high point.

District Reports. Reports from the various districts received today at H. headquarters are as follows: Portland—There has been no pronounced change in employment conditions here during the past week. The logging industry of the Columbia river valley, already at 75 per cent capacity, has been further hampered by forest fires. Demand for fire fighters and harvest hands have given employment to practically all available labor, and experienced help for special jobs is now hard to find.

Albion—Harvest on Grand Harbor during the past week has relieved the fire burned and all but three logging camps in this district have resumed operations. Many harvest hands returning here during the past few days and there is at present a slight surplus of wood choppers.

Tacoma—Logging operations in this district are for the most part inactive, although a number of small camps and two large camps are running. Many logs have been hauled to Gray Harbor in to the harvest fields. With the resumption of two sawmills here today, nearly all the Tacoma cutting camps are again in operation, largely on a one shift basis.

Seattle—Many workers already returning to their homes and vacation work are considered to indicate to the harvest fields of western Washington and Oregon and there is but little unemployment here. Harvest hands and millers are scarce. Jobs offered recently are fewer than two weeks ago but calls from outside points are increasing.

Shelton in Spokane. Spokane—There was a shortage of men in Spokane in the job offering last week. The demand for harvest hands is strong and there have been more calls for men from the fields than in any season the past. All necessity in this district are meeting. The Wayne is taking a slight shift in the market and is opening up its harvest work camp. The Malheur and Pacific states are sending workers to area here. Harvest hands are...

MUSSOLINI IS ON NEW TRACK

ROME, (AP)—Not satisfied with having created fascism, with having put it into effect during three arduous years, and with leaving the Italian responsibility of leading simultaneously five cabinet posts, Benito Mussolini is now undertaking the task of compensating his achievements by becoming the interpreter and historian of the political creed he brought to power.

Indicated by the almost superhuman exertions and responsibility of his unusual position, the premier has found time and energy to contribute to the political monthly, "Gorizia" (Gorizia), which he founded. This weekly writes articles, explaining the fascist conception of the "1922 revolution" and of the new labor system.

perform makeshift repairs in Halling Bay, approximately a mile off Howland in open sea. It was necessary to anchor the 11 steel ships of the fleet here because of the lack of mooring in Pearl Harbor.

It also was discovered, Capt. Griswold reported, that the yard was not equipped to make repairs to the faulty generator of the U. S. S. Pennsylvania, and it was necessary to remove the generator and send it to the mainland.

The principal improvements desired are the deepening, straightening and widening of the entrance channel; the dredging of the Pearl Lagoon to provide anchorage and mooring for the fleet, and increased repair facilities. Recently Senator Frankford, chief of the naval affairs committee, said after an inspection of Pearl Harbor that the next Congress probably would provide for enlarging the channel as the next step in a \$100,000,000 naval base program, and that other improvements would follow.
