HARRIS BACKS TEAM TO WIN

NEW YORK (AP) - "They may call my team a pack of discards, but before this pennant race is over they'll wish it was a miracle."

That's what Stanley Harris, manager of the world's champion Washington American league team, thinks of his 1925 band in the eight-pennant battle now pending at Ben Johnson's table of fortune.

"I can't say I'm disappointed," Harris said. "I thought Stanley Cavoschick was through out in Cleveland. I picked him up and you can look at the records to see whether he was an ace or a dunce. He is the leading pitcher in the league right now with 13 victories in 14 starts."
