HIGH SPOT SELECTED. WASHINGTON (By the Associated Press).—A high spot on the slope of Arlington, overlooking the capital, near the monument erected to those who died on the Maine, was tentatively selected today as a burial place for William Jennings Bryan.

Marion Loganberries Sold. SALLIS, Ore.—With the loganberry season at a close, estimates fixed the 1925 yield, handled in Salem at between 2,500 and 3,000 tons. Returns from the crop probably exceeded \$275,000. Practically all of the loganberries were sold on a cash basis, with the result that the growers received their money within a few days after they arrived in the local market. Of the money received from the sale of the loganberries approximately \$100,000 went to the pickers, who averaged 1 1/2 cents for picking.



Chicago Will Change Channel Of River to Help Traffic

CHICAGO, (AP)—Cutting a new channel nearly a mile long through one of the most congested business sections of Chicago, while river traffic continues in the old course, is the project to be undertaken by Chicago in straightening the Chicago River. It will be done as a means of relieving traffic congestion.

The new channel which will pass through a part of the city now covered with car storage tracks and freight warehouses, will make possible the opening of four important streets connecting the south side of the city with the business district and also the rearranging of tracks and terminals, thereby reclaiming a large area for business purposes.

The channel will be 200 feet wide and 28 feet deep in the central 100-foot sloping to 16 feet deep at the dock lines. The project involves the moving of two bridges, the construction of five others and an excavation of 1,000,000 cubic yards at a mechanical cost of more than \$3,000,000.

A heavy river traffic must be maintained while construction is under way. The transfer of property of the Chicago and Northwestern and the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy railroads from the west to the east sides of the river will be necessary.

Operations will begin as soon as condemnation proceedings can be put through to obtain the necessary land and riparian rights, says Hugh Young, head of the city plan commission. The commission's plans include the rebuilding of all freight and passenger terminals of the 14 railroads running into the Dearborn, LaSalle and Grand Central stations.—Our large passenger station will house all these railroads. Under the new management of tracks provided by this plan, it will be possible to cover them with hotels and office buildings.

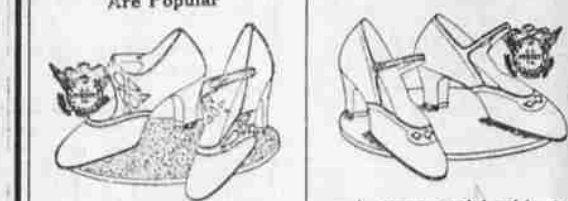
