SALT LAKE CITY (AP)—Mormons of ancient Southern Utah, cliff dwellers, weapons, agricultural implements and other relics, declared by some archeologists to be among the finest specimens in existence, are housed in the small museum of the Mormon Church, located on Temple Block here. The museum, visited annually by thousands of tourists, also contains many relics of Mormon pioneer days such as spinning wheels and household implements.

What is declared to be the first house built in Utah—it is nearly 200 years old—stands just outside the main museum building.
