DECISION TO BE GIVEN SHORTLY

Motion Against Writ of Review Secured by Jack LaBine Filed by City Attorney.

Judge J. W. STILL HOPES FOR SOME AGREEMENT

Sees No Necessity for Immediate Federal Action; the Government's Course Still Uncertain.

SWAMPSCOTT (By the Associated Press).—Concerned but not alarmed over the breakdown of anthracite operators and miners in wage negotiations at Atlantic City last night, President Coolidge kept a close tab on the situation today without indicating what action, if any, the government would take if suspension of mining operations September first becomes a certainty.
