O'Connell has the ability to be a champion, but probably never will be. He lacks the ability to grasp the psychological moment to do his big stuff.

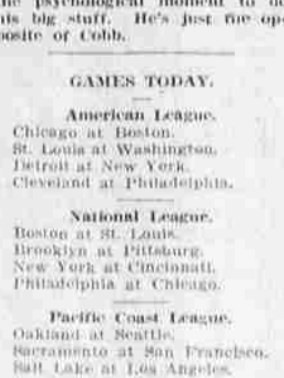

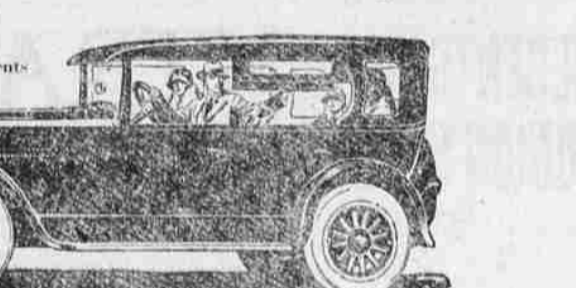
