### SALEM SUICIDE UNKNOWN

SALEM, Ore.—Police were attempting to identify a man whose body was found lying on the bank of the Willamette river here. The man had committed suicide by drinking a quantity of cyanide and shooting himself through the right temple with a .38-caliber revolver. Police said the man apparently was about 55 years of age, weighed 150 pounds and his hair was sprinkled with gray. He was dressed in a suit of black material, black hat and brown shirt. Every mark of identification had been destroyed with the exception of a hen's-tooth bearing the laundry mark 190-X.

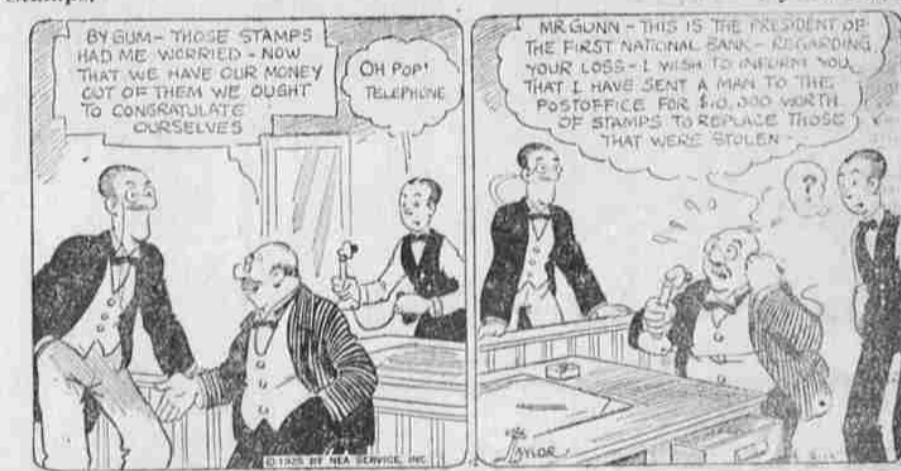
