ROAD BIDS TO COME UP

SALTM, Ore. (Special)—Bids for the construction of approach, 500 ft. 50 miles of highway and three bridges will be considered at a meeting of the state highway commission to be held in Portland Thursday, August 27.

The projects for which bids will be considered follow: Baker county—Hogback-Milguch section of Baker-Fairy highway, 12.45 miles of grading; Eagle creek-Emigrant creek section of Baker-Granville highway, 2.5 miles of crushed gravel surfacing.

Deschutes county—Bond-Lava section of The Dalles-Columbia highway, 9.95 miles of grading. Lane county—Sutton Lake-Florence section of Rosevelt east highway, 6.15 miles of grading. Washington county—Paving of approaches to Dairy creek bridge on Thonith valley highway near Hillsboro.

Curry county—Bridge near Hunters creek on Rosevelt east highway near Gold Beach. Tualuma county—Two bridges over Umbilla river on county roads at Echo and Starfield.

Germany Orders Free Entrance Visas to Competing Sportsmen

BERLIN, (AP)—The German foreign office instructed its representatives throughout Europe and North America to grant visas free of charge to all foreign sportsmen coming to Germany for sporting competitions of any description.

The measure is the result of a request by the German Sports Union, which also had asked that the foreign office take up the other governments the question of reciprocal passports for German sportsmen taking part in foreign competitions.
