Two Irish Wireless Stations Torn Down

DUBLIN (AP)—The two great Irish wireless stations at Clifden, County Galway, and at Ballybunion, County Kerry, are being dismantled and sold in lots or broken up for scrap.

Union with the general railway system at Listowel has been discontinued. When constructed it was supposed that its smaller demand for space for the track would lead to its general adoption throughout Europe but it found no imitators.

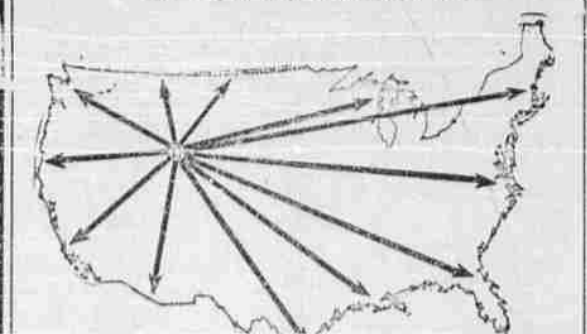
