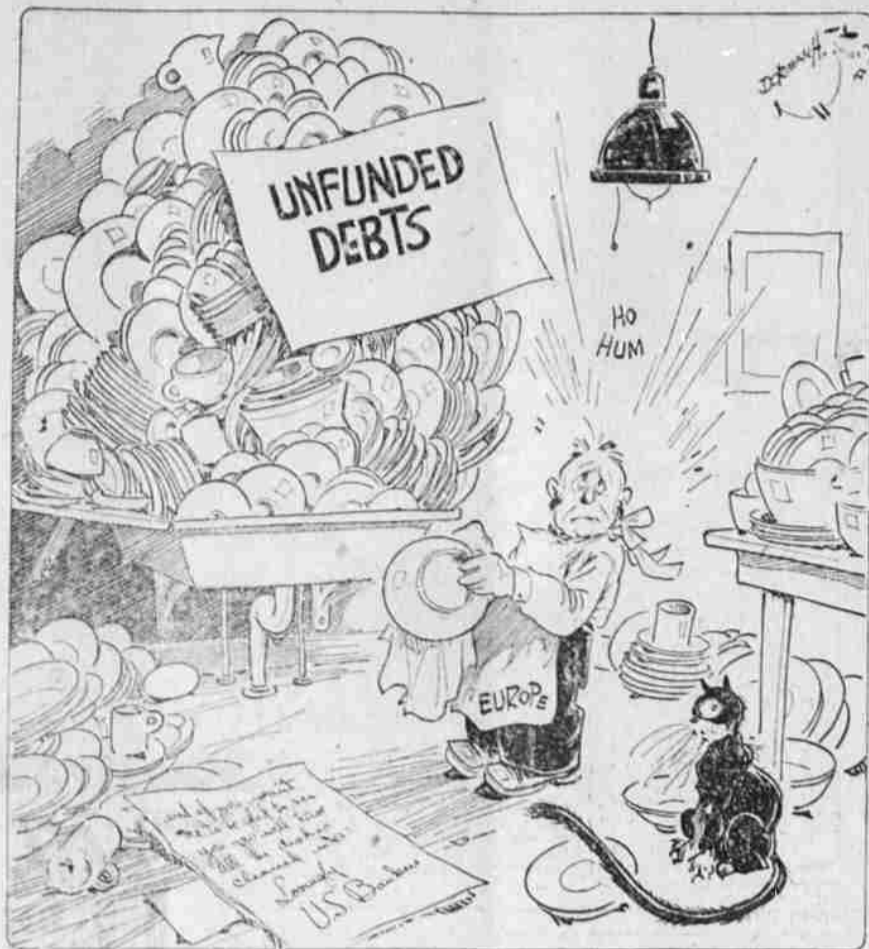
**HIG PEAT TRACT AFFIR.**
